GWC investors can post job openings into their member portal or request it to be added by their team member. Once published, those open jobs feed into the GWC weekly email blast that reaches 2,286 subscribers and is viewable on the job posting section of the GWC website. Postings can be as simple as a link to the employer's website, or full descriptions and information on how to apply. Indiana Career Connect

Indiana Career Connect (ICC) provides free workforce services and tools to help employers connect with job-ready talent. Employers can create a registered account or access ICC as a guest. Once inside, employers can begin to post available openings and search for best-matched candidates. ICC's website also offers labor market services, such as area labor market summaries. Registered employers are able to: post job orders, search the system's database for candidate résumés and find matches based on qualifications, perform searches using an expanded range of advanced search options, and create automated candidate searches that deliver résumés to your message box, e-mail address, or bot.
