## City of Wabash Tax Abatement Process

The abatement of property taxes on new investments into the City of Wabash, which could be offered for **real and/or personal property** (subject to final local approval) typically for a phased-in period of **up to 10 years**, can result in very significant savings to a project.

Once a business has consulted with Grow Wabash County and/or financial advisors to determine the investment amount and appropriate property category, the following steps must be completed:

## Application Review

Once Grow Wabash County has received both the proper SB-1 Form and completed abatement application, a member of the GWC team will review the request and determine the project's abatement score.

The **abatement score** will determine if the project qualifies and, if so, the length of the abatement.

# Incentive Committee Recommendation

Once the abatement score and length are determined, Grow Wabash County will convene the **City of Wabash Incentive Review Authority** (IRA). The IRA will choose whether or not to submit a **favorable recommendation** to the **Wabash City Council** for final approval of the abatement.

Attend scheduled IRA meeting to explain the project and answer questions.

### City Council Approval

Upon receiving a favorable recommendation from the IRA, the abatement request will then be reviewed by the **Wabash City Council** during its next scheduled meeting.

Attend scheduled Wabash City Council meeting to explain the project and answers questions.

The Wabash City Council will then vote to **approve or deny** the resolution to award the abatement(s).

#### Final Steps

In order for the abatement to take effect, the company must complete and submit the following forms based on the type of abatement:

#### **Personal Property Abatement**

- Real Property Abatement
- Form 104 & Form 103 for Business
  Tangible Personal Property
  Assessment Return
- Form 322/RE for Deduction from Assessed Valuation of Structures in ERAs
- Signed copies of the <u>SB-1/PP</u> and approved <u>resolution</u>
- Signed copies of the <u>SB-1/RP</u> and approved <u>resolution</u>
- Submit to the Wabash County Assessor's office by Dec. 31 of the same year.
- Submit to the <u>Wabash County</u> <u>Auditor's</u> office by Dec. 31 of the same year.

## Annual Compliance

Submit completed and signed <u>Compliance with Statement of Benefits</u> (<u>CF-1) Form</u> for Real Property or Personal Property (whichever is appropriate) to the Wabash County Assessor/Auditor by May 15th of each year in the abatement term.
